That Pacific Mountain Regional Council

1. Receive the document Kairos Palestine II “A Moment of Truth: Faith in a Time of Genocide” and endorse it for study, reflection and action by the Region and communities of faith and other ministries; and
2. Endorse for engagement by the Region, United Church people, ministries, communities of faith and the Governments of Canada, British Columbia and Yukon (as relevant) the actions in Kairos Palestine II including but not limited to those calling on people of conscience to:
 - a. name the reality truthfully;
 - b. To work for the creation of an alternative, just and humane world order as the present global system has failed in its most important responsibilities: to defend the weak and to preserve international peace and security;
 - c. advocate for accountability and international law
 - d. reject theologies that justify oppression: reject and refuse to legitimate hateful ideologies such as Christian Zionism, Islamophobia and antisemitism;
 - e. encourage courageous and costly solidarity with the people of Palestine and especially the diminishing Christian community; and
 - f. support creative, nonviolent resistance, specifically but not solely boycott, divestment and sanctions.
3. That a resource be prepared that outlines the actions of Kairos Palestine II for distribution throughout the Regional Council.
